We wish to inform you that With 9% growth over the last five years, India's exports to Canada increased from USD 2.31 billion in 2017 to USD 3.55 billion in 2021. The upcoming month will see the start of the **second round of free trade agreement negotiations to increase trade between India and Canada.**

In the earlier rounds of discussions, Canada had previously suggested some Product Specific Rules of Origin (PSRs) for goods related to our industry. You are required to review the PSRs of your product(s) that Canada had previously recommended (at a 6 Digit level), and to comment on whether they are appropriate for our industry.
