# A report on Plexconcil's Indian Pavillion at PLASTEURASIA 2023 SHOW | ISTANBUL | TURKIYE

NOVEMBER 22-25, 2023

The PLEXCONCIL in its endeavour to promote the export of plastics products took part in 32<sup>nd</sup> edition of PlastEurasia 2023 Show, Istanbul, Turkiye with 9 exhibitors.

The PlastEurasia Istanbul Fair, the plastic industry's largest trade show in Eurasia and second only to China among annual trade shows worldwide and with over 1,400 exhibitors and 65,000 industry professionals, the fair serves as a platform to showcase the latest technologies and innovations.



Plast Eurasia Istanbul Fair that showcases a wide variety of products, including plastics machinery, machinery equipment and sub-industry, moulds, recycling, heat and control devices, automation, cooling systems, raw materials, chemicals, and semi-finished goods. This year, foreign exhibitor rate of the fair has increased by 73 percent. The fair has sold out two months in advance of its opening, which resulted in opening two new halls for visits in 2023. Exhibitors from all over the world participating in the fair to display their products will meet visitors from leading countries such as Germany, the UK, Poland, the Netherlands, Spain and Iran.

## **Indian Pavilion:**

The Indian pavilion had 9 Exhibitors displaying products like Masterbatches, Pigments, other Raw Materials and Machineries related to Extrusion & Injection Moulding. The exhibition provided a great platform for the exhibitors at the show to gain more market access for the Indian Products in Turkev and neighbouring Countries such as African Middle East, and CIS Countries.

India Branding was created along with the Exhibitor's directory which was distributed to potential buyers



at the show. The Council had a booth to promote its activities including the promotion and sourcing of Buyers & Exhibitors for PLEXCONNECT 2024.

The inputs received from the exhibitors had positive views. They felt that the show was more productive and focussed on Raw Materials and Machineries. However, they felt that entering into the Turkish market is quite important considering the India's bilateral trade with other neighbouring countries and also the vast opportunities to be explored and to substitute the Chinese market presence.

H.E. Shri. Mijito Vinito, Consul General, Consulate General of India, Istanbul-Turkey, inaugurated and visited the India Pavillion at PlastEurasia Show 2023 and had fruitful interactive discussions with Indian Exhibitors to understand the overview of the Plastic Industry in India and also its trade with Turkey.
