## Subject: Seeking Imposition Of Safeguard (Quantitative Restrictions) On Imports Of PVC Suspension Resins (URGENT)

We wish to inform you that CHEMPLAST CUDDALORE VINYLS LIMITED and DCW LIMITED have filed a Petition Seeking Imposition Of Safeguard (Quantitative Restrictions) On Imports Of PVC Suspension Resins.

Directorate General of Trade Remedies (DGTR) has given notice regarding Safeguard (Quantitative Restrictions) investigation concerning imports of PVC Suspension Resins with Residual VCM above 2 PPM (<u>https://www.dgtr.gov.in/sites/default/files/Initiation%20%20Notification.pdf</u>)

We had a meeting of different Associations-AIPMA, OPPI etc. During this meeting it was decided to oppose Safeguard (Quantitative Restrictions) On Imports Of PVC Suspension Resins through an Advocate having experience in such matters.

During the investigation pertaining to levy of Anti-Dumping Duty (ADD) on imports of LDPE from various countries, we had engaged World Trade Consultants & Advocates, Delhi.

We have attached herewith the mail received from World Trade Consultants & Advocates, Delhi and also the notice issued by DGTD pertaining to **Initiation Of Safeguard** (Quantitative Restrictions) Investigation Concerning Imports Of PVC Suspension Resins With Residual VCM Above 2 PPM (Link – Letter from Advocate & Link – Letter to importer).
