



A Report on India Pavilion at NPE 2024 6-10, May 2024 Orlando | USA

The Plastics Export Promotion Council hosted the India Pavilion at the NPE 2024 (National Plastics Exhibition 2024) held in Orlando, Florida, USA from 6-10, May 2024. The Indian Pavillion had 13 companies who displayed their products and services.



About - NPE - the Plastics Show from 6-10 May 2024

This edition is being conducted after 2018 which has generated more interest from the industry overall. The next edition has been announced at the same venue from May 3-7, 2027.

India Pavilion

The Indian Pavillion is hosted with 13 exhibitors (covering a 2000 sqft area) from across India. The India Branding was effectively visible on all three openings of the pavilion. The Indian Pavilion branding was appreciated by all the stakeholders including the organisers of NPE. location of the pavilion was the highlight as it was in the main aisle attracting a large number of buyers to visit the pavilion. The feedback was excellent as every day the number of footfalls increased along with the



business generation. The exhibitor's catalog containing all the details for the participants was distributed at the show and at the available avenues to promote India.

Inauguration of the Indian Pavilion

Mr. Madan Kumar Ghildiya, Deputy Consul General, Consulate General of India, Atlanta,

USA inaugurated the India Pavilion on 6th May 2024. He visited all the other exhibitors interacting with them to know about their feedback. Mr. Hemant Minocha, Chairman, Plexconcil welcomed him briefed him about the Council's various activities and the major thrust being given to the

Officials Meetings:

Organisers NPE

A meeting was organized with the NPE organizers to discuss the current show and also to confirm the space requirements for the 2027 edition to be held at the same venue from 3-7, 2027.

Mr Hemant Minocha, Chairman congratulated the entire team from NPE for their great effort in making it happen after 2018 a gap of 6 years. He



informed me that the Indian exhibitors were happy with the footfalls and their interactions with genuine buyers. Mr. Vikram Bhaduria, Vice Chairman said that this year they were quite happy with the business.

The following points were discussed,

- 1. The Plexconcil has requested 4000 sq ft (doubling from 2024) for the 2027 edition.
- 2. The current location is preferred for 2027
- 3. The 4000 can be in two locations in South Lobby, especially in bringing in recycling companies from India
- 4. 1000 sq ft as a buffer to be allocated to the Council in the West Wing.
- 5. NPE to provide marketing/promotional avenues as a package
- 6. To maintain one Indian Pavillion for the next edition.
