**Subject: Regarding member inputs on allowing market access to New Zealand Exporters in India**

We wish to inform you that the Office of the DCPC has requested feedback or comments from the industry on providing preferential market access to New Zealand exporters for 86 identified plastic products.

The insights gathered through this exercise will assist the government in understanding the industry's views on liberalizing market access for New Zealand exporters in these products and, accordingly, in offering appropriate preferential tariff rates under the ongoing India-New Zealand FTA negotiations.

We are pleased to share with you the list of HS codes for which New Zealand has requested preferential market access to India. You are kindly requested to indicate your preference among the options below, along with appropriate justification for the HS codes relevant to your business interests:

Tariff Elimination Immediate -Duty will be "0" from the date of Implementation

Tariff Elimination in Phased manner - Duty will become "0" after certain period of time from the date of Implementation

Tariff Reduction- Duty will be reduced in phased manner

Tariff Rate Quota- Duty will be lower or zero for a specific quantity of goods (the "quota") and imports exceeding that quantity face a standard MFN rate.
