Subject: Regarding input for Budget Proposals for the year 2026-2027 in respect of Petrochemical Sector.

The Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals is initiating the process for formulation of proposals for the **Union Budget 2026-27**, which involves a **review of the Basic Custom Duties (BCD)** structure in the petrochemicals sector.

In this context, members are requested to share inputs **with regard to Basic Custom Duties (BCD) for specific products in the petrochemicals sector**, providing the impact of inverted duty structure affecting the petrochemical sector.

The following guidelines must be kept in mind while submitting inputs:

- Import Price & Domestic Price
- Installed capacity and corresponding volume of indigenous production
- Data on imports/exports for the past 3 years
- Domestic requirements & Demand Supply situation.
