Dear Member,

India has signed a landmark Free Trade Agreement with New Zealand that provides zero duty market access for Indian goods in this country.

This agreement will enhance the price competitiveness of Indian plastic products, particularly in value added segments such as finished articles and packaging materials.

Specifically, Indian exporters may benefit from elimination of 5% MFN duty on Plastic articles (HS 392690), Packaging materials (HS 392390), Films & Sheets (HS 392010), Kitchenware (HS 392410) and Pipes & Fittings (HS 391723) in the New Zealand market.

India may also benefit from new export opportunities in industrial and high value plastic applications, enabling a shift towards higher value added exports.

This agreement facilitates greater integration into New Zealand's import ecosystem, particularly in segments driven by cost efficiency and product customisation.
