Subject: Regarding India–UK Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) – Notification of Rules of Origin (Effective 15 July 2026).

The Government of India has issued **Notification No. 62/2026-Customs (N.T.) dated 3rd July 2026**, notifying the Customs Tariff (Determination of Origin of Goods under the Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement between India and the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) Rules, 2026. The Rules shall come into force from **15th July 2026**.

The notification lays down the framework for determining the origin of goods and the procedures to avail preferential tariff benefits under the India–UK Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA).

The key highlights include:

- Criteria for determining originating goods, including wholly obtained, wholly produced, and product-specific Rules of Origin.
- Product Specific Rules (PSRs) and Qualifying Value Content (QVC) requirements for eligible products.
- Procedures for issuance and acceptance of Proof of Origin/Certificate of Origin.
- Documentation and record-keeping requirements for exporters, producers, and importers.
- Provisions relating to verification of origin, customs cooperation, and post-import verification.
- Guidelines on non-alteration, cumulation, tolerance, and treatment of accessories, packaging, and indirect materials.
- Conditions for claiming preferential tariff treatment and provisions for late claims, refunds, and penalties in case of incorrect claims.

Members exporting, or intending to export, plastic products to the United Kingdom are advised to carefully study the enclosed notification and familiarize themselves with the applicable Rules of Origin and compliance requirements to effectively avail the tariff concessions under the India–UK CETA.
