Greetings from Plexconcil!

The Government of India is currently negotiating a Free Trade Agreement (FTA) with the five country regional group - Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU). The five members of this group are: Armenia, Belarus, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, and Russia.

As part of these negotiations, the Government has sought industry inputs on Product Specific Rules of Origin (PSR) for 138 plastic products, including seven masterbatches. India's export of these 138 goods to EAEU is USD 123 million and import is USD 50 million.

A robust and well-defined Product Specific Rule of Origin (PSR) is essential to ensure that only products genuinely manufactured in the FTA partner countries qualify for preferential tariff benefits. This will help prevent misuse of FTA concessions by products originating from third countries through transshipment or minimal processing.
