Subject: Request for Inputs on PSRs for India-Canada trade agreement

The Government of India is negotiating a Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA) with Canada to promote seamless trade between both the countries.

In this regard, Canada has shared its proposal for Product Specific Rules of Origin (PSR) for 131 Petrochemical products.

As per its proposal, Canada has suggested the PSR criteria '**CTH**' for 25 value added products (HS 3918 – HS 3925). For another 38 value added products (HS 3916-HS 3921), Canada has suggested '**CTSH**'.

For raw materials and plastic scrap (HS 3901-HS 3915), Canada suggested "**CTH, provided non-originating polymer content does not exceed 60% by weight of the total polymer content**".
