Subject: Regarding input for Revenue Related Pre- Budget Proposals for the year 2027-2028.

The Department of Commerce, Government of India, has initiated the **Pre-Budget Exercise for the Union Budget 2027–28** and has invited **revenue-related**

Pre-Budget Proposals pertaining to **Direct Taxes, Indirect Taxes, levies, and measures for streamlining procedures**, for onward recommendation to the

Ministry of Finance.

In this regard, members are requested to submit their suggestions/proposals in the prescribed format for consideration by the Department of Commerce;

While submitting the proposals, members are requested to ensure the following :-

1. The proposals should be complete in all respects and properly categorized, with the relevant **HS Codes** for each commodity.
2. The justification in support of each proposal should be **restricted to 300 words**. Supporting documents/annexures may be attached, if required.
3. For proposals relating to changes in **Indirect Taxes/Customs Duties** on specific commodities, the following information should be provided:
 - Customs Tariff Classification (HS Code)
 - Price trends
 - Existing incidence of duties
 - Domestic demand and supply situation
 - Import and export data
 - Probable impact of the proposed changes on the industry
4. **GST-related proposals are not required** and should not be submitted.
5. For proposals relating to **Direct Taxes**, complete details and justification should be provided. It should also be clearly indicated whether the proposal requires any legislative amendment

to the Direct Tax laws.

6. Issues that have been repeatedly raised over the years but have not been accepted by the Government may not be proposed again.

Further, members submitting **repeat proposals** are requested to also provide the proposals submitted during the **last three years**, indicating their priority. Fresh

proposals should clearly indicate whether they are of "**High Priority**" or "**Priority**".

Members are requested to forward their proposals to PLEXCONCIL **latest by 03.08.2026**, enabling the Council to compile and submit the consolidated industry

recommendations to the Department of Commerce within the stipulated timeline.

We look forward to your valuable suggestions to strengthen the competitiveness of India's plastics export sector through the Union Budget 2027–28.
