This has reference to our trailing circular on the Department of Chemicals and Petrochemical's (DCPC) query related to India's Market Access proposal under the ongoing India-Israel FTA negotiation.

Since we have not received any input from the industry, we would like to submit the following Market Access Proposal for 504 Plexconcil products (click the link below):

— We have proposed Immediate Tariff Elimination to facilitate imports of 110 Raw Materials and 5 Masterbatch, where India is a net importer.

— We have suggested not to commit any tariff liberalisation on the remaining 389 products (including 32 raw materials, 82 Masterbatch and 275 value added products) where India is self-sufficient or where we need to promote domestic value addition and Make in India.

Members may go through the HS code-wise tariff liberalisation proposal from the above link and send their feedback, including objections, if any, by mentioning their HS Codes to bharti@plexconcil.org and research@plexconcil.org by 5 pm, Wednesday, 20 August July 2026, to enable timely submission to Government of India.

Subject: Request for Stakeholders' Inputs on India's Market Access Offer to Israel

We wish to inform members that, as part of the ongoing India-Israel trade negotiations, Israel has sought market access in the Indian market for various products, including different petrochemical tariff lines.

The 2nd round of negotiations with Israel was held in July 2026, and the next round of negotiations is expected shortly. In this regard, the Government of India is in the process of finalizing India's market access offer to Israel.

Members are requested to examine the tariff lines provided in the Excel file (https://membership.plasticsepc.org/maills_images/20260817010905.xlsx) and furnish their product-wise inputs/comments on the proposed tariff liberalization for imports from Israel.

Members are specifically requested to fill in the last three columns of the Excel file, as follows:

- Whether Tariff to be Liberalized (Yes/No) – 1st Round Response
- Preferred Tariff Staging – EIF / TEP / TR
- Reason for the Chosen Stand – Please provide a brief and specific justification for the recommendation.

Preferred Tariff Staging:

Term	Meaning	Final tariff
EIF – Tariff Elimination upon Entry into Force	Tariff becomes 0% immediately when the agreement comes into force.	0% immediately
TEP – Phased Tariff Elimination	Tariff is reduced gradually over an agreed period until it reaches 0%.	0% eventually
TR – Phased Tariff Reduction	Tariff is reduced gradually, but does not necessarily become 0%.	Reduced tariff, but above 0%

Members are requested to carefully assess the impact of tariff liberalization on the domestic industry, including domestic production, import dependence, competitiveness and any sensitivity of the respective products.

The inputs received from members will be consolidated and submitted to the concerned Government authorities for consideration in the forthcoming round of India–Israel trade negotiations.
