#### **SUMMARY OF EXPORTS**

Export of plastic products declined 15.1% to USD 968.9 million in October 2025 from USD 1141.9 million in the year ago month, registering the second consecutive month of contraction in the current financial year because of US tariff headwind. Export of value added plastics posted 14.0% decline, while shipment of plastic raw materials contracted 21.2%. On the other hand, export of Human Hair & Related Products fell 2.8% because of lower shipment to USA and weak demand in Paraguay.

Miscellaneous products is the only category which showed positive growth in exports (15.4%) during the month.

On a cumulative basis, Plexconcil exports grew 1.5% to USD 7375.8 million in April-October 2025 from USD 7264.8 million in the year ago period.










# **ANALYSIS OF INDIA'S PLASTICS EXPORT**





#### **KEY FINDINGS**

Plastic exports posted second consecutive monthly decline during October 2025 as shipments to the major market, USA, was adversely affected by the hike in tariff.

During the month, plastic exports fell 15.1% led by decline in shipment of all product panels, except Miscellaneous items (which managed to post 15.4% growth).

In the Miscellaneous category, there was a sharp growth in export of Optical Fibres and Cables (HS 90011000) because of strong demand in USA (despite the tariff hike).




#### I TREND IN OVERALL EXPORTS

India's merchandise exports posted 11.82% decline to USD 34.37 billion in October 2025 from USD 38.98 billion in the year ago month because of contraction in shipments of major categories such as petroleum, engineering goods, gems & jewellery, chemicals, textiles, handicrafts and most of the agro commodities. The fall in exports comes amidst the imposition of additional tariff by USA, which is the largest market for Indian goods.

During April-October 2025, exports posted 0.63% growth to USD 254.25 billion from the year ago period.

(USD Billion)





#### TREND IN PLASTICS EXPORT

During October 2025, India's plastic exports declined 15.1% to USD 969 million from USD 1,142 million in the year ago month. However, cumulative exports during April-October 2025 posted 1.5% growth to USD 7,376 million from USD 7,265 million in the year ago period as exporters frontloaded shipments to USA ahead of the implementation of the additional US tariff.

#### | PLASTICS EXPORT, BY PANEL

In October 2025, export of all the product panels witnessed decline except Miscellaneous products and items. Notably, there was sharp fall in exports of films and sheets, raw materials, floorcovering & laminates during the month. Miscellaneous item is the only product panel that managed to post positive growth (15.4%) in October 2025.

#### **Exports of Consumer & Houseware Products**

declined 9.2% led by sharp decline in shipment of tableware and kitchenware (HS 39241090) to USA; USA accounts for 25% of India's total exports of this product. There was also fall in export of other products such as Tooth Brushes (HS 96032100), Other Household and Toilet Articles (HS 39249090) to USA.

**Cordage, Fishnets & Monofilaments** fell 23.4% because of weak demand for Other Cordage (HS 56074900) in USA and UAE. Shipment of Monofilament related plastic products (HS 39169028) was also affected by rise in the US tariff. Exporters also faced decline in order inflows for other related products (HS 39169090) in Bangladesh.

**FIBC, Woven Sacks and Women Fabrics** exports declined 5.7% led by fall in sales of Other Woven Fabrics (HS 54072090), Sacks & Bags (HS 39232990), FIBC products (HS 63053200) to USA, which is the principal market for these products.



**Export of Floor Coverings, Leather Cloth & Laminates** fell 34.6% because of remarkable contraction in shipment of Other Fabrics (HS 59039090) and Other PVC Floorcovering (HS 39181090) to USA. There was also weak demand for Other PVC Coated Fabrics (HS 59031090) in UAE, apart from USA.

**Export of FRP & Composites** contracted 12.6% led by sharp decline in shipment of Other Plastic Articles (HS 39269099) to USA, which is the leading market, accounting for more than 40% of India's exports in this category.

**Export of Human Hair & Related Products** fell 2.8% because of decline in sales of Dressed or Worked Human Hair (HS 67030010) to USA. There is also weak demand for this product in Paraguay, which is one of the top 5 export destinations for this product.

**Medical Items of Plastics** posted 10.7% decline in exports because of fall in sales of Cannulae (HS 90183930), Catheters (HS 90183910) and other products to USA. There was also weak demand for other Medical items such as Blood Transfusion Apparatus (HS 90189032) in Belgium and other markets, besides USA.

**Miscellaneous Products & Items n.e.s.** is the only panel that posted positive growth (15.4%) during the month because of more than 3-fold growth in shipment of Optical fibres and cables (HS 90011000) to USA despite the

hike in US tariff. USA is the leading market as 28% of Indian shipment goes to this market for this product (HS '90011000). There was also strong demand for PVC Belt Conveyor (HS 39269010) in Canada.



**Packaging Items - Flexible, Rigid** witnessed 16% decline in exports because of sharp fall in shipments of Sacks & Bags of Polyethylene (HS 39232100) to USA, which accounts for more than 50% of India's exports. There is also weak demand for this product in UK, which is one of the leading markets. Exporters are also facing weak order inflows from neighbouring countries such as Sri Lanka and Nepal for Bottle Caps and Closures (HS 39235010).

Shipment of **Plastic Films & Sheets** contracted 13.0% in September 2025, mainly due to lower shipment of Flexible plates, sheets of propylene (39202020) to Mexico, Spain, Colombia and other markets. There was also a fall in exports of flexible plates and sheets of PET (39206220) to USA, Italy, Spain, Netherland. Exporters also faced weak demand in USA, UAE, South Africa and other markets for products such as Self-adhesive plates (39199090), Other Plates and Sheets (39219099).

Export of **Plastic Pipes & Fittings** have fallen 21.2% because of decline in sales of Flexible Tubes, Pipes and Hoses (HS 39173100) and Other Tubes Pipes and Hoses (HS 39173990) to USA. There is also weak demand for plastic fittings for Tubes, Pipes and Hoses in Nepal, Saudi Arabia and Bangladesh in recent months. Indian exporters have also faced slowdown in orders from Iraq, Mexico and Oman for Other Tubes and Pipes (HS 39172390).

Export of **Plastic Raw Materials** witnessed 21.2% contraction in October 2025 led by weak demand for Other Acrylic Polymers (HS 39069090) in South Africa, Bangladesh and UAE. There was also decline in export of other raw materials such as Polytetrafluoroethylene (HS 39076190) to UAE. Demand for Polypropylene (HS 39021000) was also weak in key markets such as Turkey, Nepal, Viet Nam and in neighbouring markets such as Sri Lanka and Bangladesh.

Export of **Writing Instruments & Stationery** fell 29.1% in October 2025 led by lower shipment of Felt-tipped and other porous tipped pens (HS 96082000) and Other Ball Point Pens (HS 96081019) to USA. There is also weak demand for Other Ball Point Pens (HS 96081019) in Algeria, Other Ball Point Pens without Liquid Inks (HS 96081099) in Brazil and USA.

#### + GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATIONS

#### 1. Cancellation of Specified BIS Notifications

The Central Government has cancelled BIS Certifications on 14 products notified earlier by the Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers in order to ease the availability of imported raw materials for domestic manufacturers. Some of these products are: Terephthalic Acid, Ethylene Glycol, Polyethylene Material for Moulding & Extrusion, Polyproplene (PP) Materials for Moulding and Extrusion and so on.

This measure will ease compliance burden related to quality certification for importers of these raw materials.

# 2. Cabinet approves Export Promotion Mission & Credit Guarantee Scheme

The Union Cabinet chaired by Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has approved the Rs. 25,060 crore Export Promotion Mission (EPM), which will consolidate key export promotion schemes such as Interest Equalisation Scheme (IES) and Market Access Initiative (MAI). Separately, the Union Cabinet has cleared the Credit Guarantee Scheme for Exporters (CGSE) to facilitate credit flow to eligible exporters, including MSMEs.

These measures will help Indian exporters in market diversification, liquidity management, international marketing and branding efforts.

# 3. DGFT issues guidelines for Bharat Aayat Niryat LabSetu

The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has issued guidelines for Bharat Aayat Niryat LabSetu for exporters, and importers. LabSetu is a digital platform integrating testing and inspection agencies across the country under a single window, which will reduce paperwork, manual submissions, delays and increase turnaround times for testing and certification.

This guideline specifies end-to-end workflow, right from registration of applicants, Login Process to submission of sample testing applications.

# 4. Amendment in Para 2.08 of Handbook of Procedures 2023

DGFT has notified the amendments in Para 2.08 of the Handbook of the Procedures 2023 which explains the procedure for application, submission, verification and maintenance of Import Export Code. As per this amendment, the government merged Form ANF-1A with the revised ANF-2A form.

Note that Form ANF-1A stands deleted and ANF-2A is revised with immediate effect.

#### 5. RBI's Relief Measures to Exporters

Reserve Bank of India has introduced a slew of relief measures to provide comfort to exporters facing adverse impact of the prevailing global trade disruption. These measures include relaxation in FEMA regulations on maximum time limit for realisation of export proceeds and liberal time frame for shipment of goods against receipt of advance payment. The RBI also provided certain rrelaxation in repayment terms of Term Loans and Working Capital Loans, credit period for pre-shipment and post-shipment credit and liquidation norms for packing credit.

These measures are intended to provide relief in compliance procedures for exporters facing shipment delays, and maintain continuity in order execution.

# 6. Clarification on Reverse-Graduation due to Revised MSME Classification

The Office of the Development Commissioner (MSME) has issued clarification regarding reverse-graduation of MSMEs based on the revised investment and turnover criteria for classifying MSMEs. Reverse-Graduation refers to the process where enterprises that were earlier classified as larger units under old limits may now qualify as MSMEs under the new, higher limits.

Exporters may take note of this clarification and may regain MSME status if their turnover and investment fall within the revised limit.

#### 7. Revised eligibility criteria for registration on "Source from India" service of Trade Connect e Platform

DGFT has issued a trade notice regarding revision of exporter eligibility criteria for registration on "Source from India" service of Trade Connect e Platform. As per this revision, in addition to Status Holders, all exporters with valid Importer Exporter Codes (IECs) that have realized export earnings of at least USD 100,000 in any one of the previous three financial years can create microsites on "Source from India" section.

Exporters may take note of this revision and benefit from the same.

#### 8. Voluntary revision of customs entries

CBIC has issued a notification regarding new regulations for the voluntary revision of customs entries in India called the Customs (Voluntary Revision of Entries Post Clearance) Regulations, 2025 effective from 1st November 2025.

Exporters, importers and authorized customs brokers may take note of these regulations and voluntarily revise entries in bills of entry, shipping bills, bills of export, or other customs records post-clearance under Section 18A of the Customs Act, 1962.


# 9. Consolidation of 31 Customs Exemption Notifications

Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) has issued a notification consolidating 31 existing customs exemption notifications into a single notification, prescribing the effective rates of Customs Duty, IGST, and Compensation Cess on goods imported into India.


