#### TREND IN OVERALL EXPORTS

India reported merchandise exports of USD 34.5 billion in December 2022, down by 12.2% from USD 39.3 billion in December 2021. Cumulative value of merchandise exports during April 2022 – December 2022 was USD 332.8 billion as against USD 305.0 billion during the same period last year, reflecting a growth of 9.1%.




Exhibit 1: Trend in overall merchandise exports from India

### TREND IN PLASTICS EXPORT

During December 2022, India exported plastics worth USD 989 million, lower by 19.2% from USD 1,224 million in December 2021. Cumulative value of plastics export during April 2022 – December 2022 was USD 9,167 million as against USD 9,992 million during the same period last year, registering a decline of 8.3%.




Exhibit 2: Trend in plastics export by India

## PLASTICS EXPORT, BY PANEL

In December 2022, most of the product panels, namely, Plastic raw materials; Plastic films & sheets; FIBC, woven sacks, woven fabrics, & tarpaulin; FRP & Composites; Consumer & houseware products; Plastic pipes & fittings; Packaging items - flexible, rigid; Floorcoverings, leathercloth & laminates; Cordage, fishnets & monofilaments and Human hair & related products reported lower exports. However, product panels like; Medical items of plastics; Writing instruments & stationery and Miscellaneous products reported a positive growth in exports.

Export of <u>Consumer & houseware products</u> declined by 13.8% in December 2022 on account of lower sales of Household articles and toilet articles of plastics (HS code 392490). Exports of Toys of plastics (95030030) has also been showing a significant decline since May 2022 due to change in the HS code of Toys of plastics resulting in failure to capture the correct value of its exports from India. Interestingly, one of our members mentioned that demand is slowing down in Europe and the USA due to which there is a global drop in demand of 25% in toys.

<u>Cordage, fishnets & monofilaments</u> exports were lower by 10.5% in December 2022 due to slowing sales of Twine, cordage, ropes and cables of polyethylene or polypropylene (560749).

In case of <u>FIBC</u>, <u>woven sacks</u>, <u>woven fabrics</u>, <u>& tarpaulin</u>, exports in December 2022 fell by 25.2% as Indian exporters reported a decline in sales of Sacks and bags of plastics (39232990); and Flexible intermediate bulk containers (630532). Exports of Flexible intermediate bulk containers from India had hit a two year low in October 2022 due to recession concerns in

Europe. Indian exporters have indicated that Türkiye has emerged as a major threat to India in the international markets as its currency has depreciated sharply against the US Dollar.

Export of <u>Floor coverings</u>, <u>leather cloth & laminates</u> declined by 7.2% during December 2022 on account of lower sales of PVC floor coverings (391810) and Textile fabrics impregnated or coated or covered or laminated with plastics other than PVC and PU (HS code 590390) to North America.

Export of **FRP & Composites** was down by 31.7% due to lower sales of Articles of plastics and articles of other materials of heading 3901 to 3914, n.e.s (39269099).

Export of <u>Human hair & related products</u> fell by 6.1% due to a decline in sales of Human hair, dressed, thinned, bleached or otherwise worked (67030010). India's major export destination for Human hair is China where economic activity remains disturbed due to the Zero Covid policy and regular lockdowns. Indian exporters have also mentioned about smuggling of human hair from India to Myanmar through the land borders.

Export of <u>Medical items of plastics</u> witnessed an increase of 20.7% in December 2022 due to higher sales of Spectacle lenses of polymers (900150) from India to France and Cannulae (90183930) to Brazil. India has been a net exporter of Catheters for quite a few years.

Export of <u>Miscellaneous products & items nes</u> increased by 16.7% in December 2022 due to higher sales of Optical fibres, optical fibres bundles and cables (90011000).

<u>Packaging items - flexible, rigid</u> export declined by 9.8% on lower sales of Sacks and bags of polymers of ethylene (HS code 392321). North America and Europe are the largest export destinations for these products from India.

<u>Plastic films & sheets</u> export were lower by 27.8% in December 2022 due to a slide in sales of Self-adhesive sheets and films of plastics (391910, 391990); Rigid and flexible sheets of polymers of propylene (392020) and Plates and sheets of non-cellular polyethylene terephthalate (392062). Plastic films & sheets manufacturers in India have slashed production amid sluggish global demand and high inventory.

Export of <u>Plastic pipes & fittings</u> contracted by 23.1% due to poor sales of Other rigid tubes of polyethylene (391721); Other seamless tubes of polymers of vinyl chloride (HS code 39172390) and Other tubes and pipes (391731).

<u>Plastics raw materials</u> export was lower by 30.7% in December 2022 due to a decline in sales of Linear low density polyethylene (39014010); Polypropylene (390210); and Polyethylene terephthalate (390761, 390769) from India.

Export of <u>Writing instruments & stationery</u> witnessed an increase of 12.3% in December 2022 due to higher sales of Ball point pens of plastics (960810). This product segment has been doing quite well in the export market since the beginning of this year.
